Adrian, MI – The Adrian Center for the Arts is excited to present “Risk,” a regional juried show featuring artists living in Lenawee and bordering counties.

Art in several media will be displayed May 24 – June 25 in the ACA Gallery which is located in Building 46 on the PlaneWave Instruments campus. The public reception and show closing will be held from 2- 4 p.m., June 25.

Artists were encouraged to submit, through an application process, original work which explored the concept of RISK in a creative and unique, fashion, exploring the idea in artmaking, culture, myth, literature, or life experience. Juror for the show was Adrian College’s Department of Art and Design Chair and Director of the Adrian College Institute for Creativity Travis Erxleben. He is an Assistant Professor of Art and Design. Thirty five artists submitted 71 pieces.
